#### **Timelines & Funding**

- March 1<sup>st</sup> 2006 to February 28<sup>th</sup> 2008
- Total of 203 PMs
  - CERN has 20 PMs
- Total funding of 1.200.000 Euro
  - In addition, 118.000 Euro unfunded contributions
  - CERN has 195.000 Euro, no unfunded contributions



#### **CERNs Involvement**

#### CERN committed 20 PMs

- 1 fellow to be hired as of May 1<sup>st</sup> (maybe only June 1<sup>st</sup>)
  - Part of EGE group, supervised by Erwin Laure
- Tasks as specified in the TA:
  - Contribute to the ICEAGE Forum and potentially host one meeting (1PM)
    - Francois Flueckiger and Erwin Laure are forum members
  - Training the educators (2PM)
    - By providing material and participate to events
  - Support training events (11PM)
    - International Summer School on Grid computing and similar events
      - Provide material and hold courses
  - Project management (1PM)
    - Project reporting
  - Help with fund raising
    - Exploit EGEE and openlab links?



#### **CERN Synergies**

- Substantial overlap with the Grid track of CSC
  - Use ICEAGE results, in particular training material, exercises etc. at CSC
  - ICEAGE personnel will help at CSC
- CERN is not officially involved in EGEE training activity (NA3)
  - ICEAGE will provide more direct links
- ICEAGE could help with training in other SSAs
  - Like ETICS, ISSeG
