How to Control MFC oscillations (PID problem)

The reason could be the wrong PID values in the regulation loop of the MFC.

Typically, running at flows very different form the nominal may imply adjustments in the PID settings.

Typical PID settings are P=0.2 - I=2 - D=0. Nominal flow values usually work well also with PID set at P=2 and I=5. This is only a rough indication!
