

## Season 2021

- The T10 competition was introduced and was very successful
- There was a record T20 participation
- Disciplinary issues were significantly down
- CS was admitted to the ICC, a big success

## Season 2022

- Clubs are invited to submit suggestions for any changes to competition rules to Asvin by 31 December 2021
- White balls will be progressively introduced from 2022 – will be a problem for us and Cossonay, who have white kit
  - Suggested to use coloured pad sleeves for white pads and coloured bibs
- Clubs were asked to remind umpires about claiming match fees and travel expenses
- There are good online coaching videos available via the ICC
- There are a number of possible new teams - another club from Zuoz, a team from the Valais and second teams from clubs already participating in CS competitions
- There was a long discussion about sourcing kit for CS clubs, the search for suppliers is ongoing
- Clubs are asked to encourage Women's cricket, part of our ICC requirements

## Organisation structure

- CS has to comply with both ICC and Swiss Olympic regulations
- CS has to make changes to the governance, particularly with respect to the ICC, and this will be addressed in the coming months
- Clubs were asked to canvas their members to see if anyone is prepared to join specific working groups, which will most likely need to be set up to spread the workload
