

## Procedure for accessing CERN for Cricket

- a) The CERN match manager will send an e-mail to the opposing match manager giving a web link for visiting players and supporters to sign up for an access card
- b) Each person (**supporters, family, players, umpires**) coming to the match must complete a request via the above link, giving their title, name and e-mail address.

**Make sure that the slider for 'Request access to the CERN site' is selected (it should be set by default) and then they can enter their Birth date, Country of birth and Place of birth.**

- c) A CERN responsible will then grant them access to the site
- d) **This should be done at least 48 hours in advance of the match**
- e) If they **did not** select '**Yes**' for '**Request access to the CERN site**' ( point b) ) they will be sent an e-mail (**please check your spam folder if it hasn't arrived in your inbox**) requesting them to complete registration via a link to enter their Birth date, Country of birth and Place of birth **so please avoid this by registering as described in b) since it requires an extra intervention by the player and by the CERN responsible**
- f) They will then receive, via e-mail, **an access card to be printed** and presented at the CERN gate on the day of the match (**please check your spam folder if it hasn't arrived in your inbox**)
- g) If you are unable to print them you should stop at the CERN Preveessin entrance

The guard on the gate can print them for you, you need the code that was sent to you as well as proof of identity (**not an electronic copy**).

- h) Without an access card, entry onto the CERN site will not be possible**
