

Annex to the Agreement for the training of doctoral students from the Federal Republic of Germany in the framework of the CERN doctoral students programme

“Wolfgang Gentner Stipends”

Breakdown of the costs between CERN and BMBF

BMBF (via the DESY-> Gentner team account)

- monthly subsistence allowances, employer’s contribution to the health insurance scheme and family and child allowances as for doctoral students in the regular CERN programme
- once a year: duty travel expenses for the doctoral students to travel back to their home university; no subsistence allowance
- once: travel costs (transport + subsistence) + registration costs for the doctoral students to attend a suitable German national conference, e.g. *DPG-Tagung* or *VDI-Tagung*
- once: travel costs (transport + subsistence) for the CERN supervisor to travel to the doctoral student’s home university on the occasion of a thesis defence or doctoral examination

CERN

- Central budget (HR)
 - travel to and from CERN upon contract start and termination
- Group budget (CERN Group)
 - miscellaneous integration expenses such as language training, essential safety training, continuous training, etc.
 - work equipment, e.g. PC, laptop
 - once: travel costs (transport + subsistence) + registration costs for the doctoral students to attend an international conference or workshop to present their work results
 - once: invitation of the university tutor to come to CERN with reimbursement of the travel costs (transport + subsistence)

Not compulsory (usually funded by the CERN Group)

- costs of attendance at schools (e.g. CERN Computing School, CERN Accelerator School)
- additional trips to German national conferences
