### Definitions

**HW enabled TOF channel** = channel that is ON from the hardware point of view and taking data

**Enabled inefficient channel** = channel that are ON from the hardware point of view but are flagged as inefficient for any of the following reasons:

**Enabled noisy channel** = channel that have been flagged as noisy during a NOISE scan and yet are enabled

**Noisy channel** = channel that have been flagged as noisy during a NOISE scan, that can be either enabled or disabled from the hardware point of view

**Good TOF channel** = not noisy & efficient & enabled
