

Problems:

- versions later than 1.0.1 OOPS after some random time when machine is idle
 - ◆ UPDATE: version 1.0.1 also OOPS-es but it takes much longer to hit the race (> 2h)
- original backport for 2.4.x kernels emulates workqueues using timers which seems unsafe

Status:

- ipw2200 in SLC 4.x works correctly so there is not much point in maintaining this backport
 - ◆ also SLC 4.x is recommended for laptop users because of other reasons
- if there is a need somebody can check if the "idle-OOPS" problem is present in pre-1.0.1 versions of the driver which are available from dellaric's homepage (and which are much simpler than newer versions)
